We do the **worship**, we offer prayers, offerings, sacrifice, the **whole nine yards** (3).

The people are sure that they're doing everything **they can** (2), and that they're doing everything **right**.

We think that we're all **good** with God if we're doing **worship**.

Or was he dealing with the same **ritual based** (2) mentality that the prophet Micah was coping with?

Both the prophet and Jesus are **flipping the script**.

Worship is not separated as a **time apart**, but as a celebration within a **continuum** of active ministry.

“Blessed are you when you **suffer** the **consequences** of being a faithful servant of the Kingdom” is one way of summarizing the **Beatitudes**.
