We're pretty sure fellowship involves **food**, like **Pot Luck** (2).

It's so helpful that Lucado brings in the imagery of the **cave**.

Note that it isn't a matter of Jesus sprinkling **courage fairy dust** (3) on a few people.

In short, Christ speaks in **fellowship**.

There was very little that was defined as **orthodox**.

You'll notice that this "letter" has no **opening** and no **closing**.

The way that is not of Christ has changed, and we can even see it within the **New Testament** (2).

Here's one sin that rarely makes the list: **wealth**.

Their **moral imagination** (2) seemed to have embraced this call of Christ to minister sacrificially.

Scholars like to call this communal sharing a **failed experiment** (2).

What the fellowship cannot do, and still remain faithful, is to be **unchanging**.
