The teacher's **job** is to take the **abstract** content and make it **meaningful** for the student.

Cognitive **psychology** involves the **study** of internal **mental** processes.

However, all of their **learning** has to happen in the **abstract**; they can't drive a **truck**.

It says **absolutely nothing** (2) about his ministry.

The psalmist does not share a **faith based** (2) in abstractions, but in **lived experience** (2).

To whom was **Thomas** a "**Twin**" has sometimes been asked.

And besides, it was definitely **way too soon** (3) for **Jesus** jokes.

Thomas stopped doubting because **experience** is **believing**.

Communicating an **understanding** of the faith will require **faith in action**.

Second, there is **no big show** (3).

Resurrection faith means **asking questions** (2) to seek better **understanding**.
