Jesus did not leave a **Manual of Operations**.

“And see, I am sending upon you what **my Father promised** (3).”



Jesus is **keenly** aware that the world’s powers have regarded him with **hate** and **loathing**.

That last word, **sanctification**, is important.

Individually, they don’t count for much.

A key point in all of this is that **salvation** is really a shared promise, not an **individual** attribute.

Since **Judas’s betrayal** (2) and departure, they have been **incomplete**.

I find it interesting that **baptism** by John was a prerequisite.

After they **prayed about** (2) it, there were still **two candidates** (2).

The most **radical** thing we might do is **pray** someplace where people don’t usually **pray**.

The disciples asked how, pointing to the **scarcity** of what they had.
