

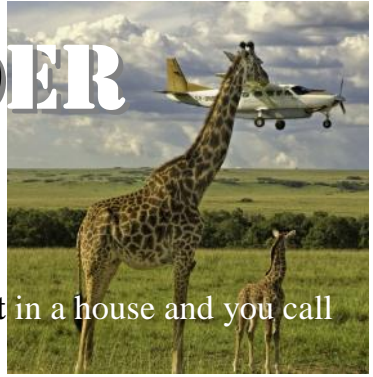
# FAIR-FIELDER

“Say you think there is an **insurgent** in a house and you call in **air support** (2).”



The call to **serve** can have **dimensions** that we'd never imagine.

It could easily be said that God's people have made their **routine** of **worship** into a matter of occasional **piety**.

We might assume that **Isaiah** is there for **worship** on a regular basis.

This song of **divine praise** (2) is a call to worship and **adoration** of God.

Isaiah was sure that he was **inadequate** for **anything**.

This seems rather **furtive**, but it may also have been what Jesus's people **arranged**.

Nicodemus shows a **knack** for saying the **obvious**, giving him a rather **dim-witted** aura.

Jesus' teaching and ministry have gotten him **questioning** his own **spirituality** and standing as a faithful servant.

Yet, even today, many people have a deep and abiding faith in a God of **judgment** and **condemnation**.

The gospel of **love** and **liberation** is not new....
