Religious rituals and **observances** of former times will be **replaced** by the fulfillment of **God's will** (2).

In Revelation, we have a **cosmic battle** (2) between God and **worldly** forces of **evil**.

It goes on to describe those **condemned** to the lake of **burning sulfur** (2).

They [God's people] are the **primary actors** (2) in bringing God's way to **fulfillment** in the world.

Those people are **erased** , purifying the **gateway** for the new **Jerusalem**.

In Revelation's **vision**, the people of God is focused on making itself **pure** and **devout**.

For Jesus, the kingdom of God comes from **seeds planted** (2).
