The vineyard is typically a **rich symbol** for the Kingdom of God.

The Lord didn't worry about having more than **twelve disciples** (2).

In fact, there are countless ways the vineyard can become **corrupted**.

For Floridians, this would be like creating an **orange grove** (2).

There is no **answer** for the heartbroken owner.

That's the harvest of this vineyard; **rotten corruption** or **poisonous indifference** or **scandalous exploitation** or **violent hostility** (2).

In every gospel editors' adaptation, the **three step** (2) progression gets a **makeover**.

Matthew sees **more prophets** (2) being sent by God closer to Jesus' time.

We end up far removed from the original **inspiration** of the Isaiah passage.

Justice and **righteousness** form the sweet harvest expected from all of us by our God.
