Son Ray has been preparing to be a **shepherd** .



The guys in that first session, I told them they were my **guinea pigs** (2).

Both passages center on personal **dislocation**.

She was **alienated** and **scorned** among the nations, abandoned by her God.

A **herald** goes out among the people, summoning them into the desert.

The landscape of our own **spirit** and **inner** life must be re-created.

This is the beginning of the gospel of Mark, the **oldest** of the gospels which has no **nativity** story at all.

John sought to put them in a **right relationship** (2) with their God.

He was decidedly not a **priest**, not a **Pharisee**, not a **Sadducee**.

What it means exactly is always dependent on what we're prepared to **receive**.
