Isaiah recognizes **hopelessly stupid** (2) when he sees it.

But since you can't find your **spine** much less any  
**faithfulness**, condemnation comes.

It is God's witness of shared **purpose** with God's people as  
well as shared **presence**.

Like King **Ahaz**, Joseph doesn't seek a **sign**.

The **angel** simply confirms and expands on what **Joseph**  
had learned from **Mary**.

The problem is that when God acts in a **surprising** way,  
God is very willing to make a **mess** of our lives.

But the true life of faith **sojourns** without knowing exactly  
where the **road leads** (2).
